

Parent Leader Pack 51 Meeting
October 6, 2008

Jennifer Schmid called the meeting to order at 7:32p.m. Lynn Renezeder prepared a sign in sheet.

- I. September Minutes: Minutes were reviewed and read by all. Chad Scott motioned to approve the minutes and Jason Johnson made the second.
- II. Past Events:
 - a) September Pack Meeting: This event was terrific. Because it was the first Pack meeting of the year, time went over. Overall, it was a success. Any boys who received duplicate belt loops (archery) are asked to return the newly distributed ones to the Pack.
 - b) Watershed Clean-up: About 25 – 30 scouts from Pack 51 participated in this year's event at Santiago Park. This event was great because the boys understood what it means to help in a group effort.
- III. Treasurer Report: God and Me Reimbursement request from Den 2 was discussed at length as to we have a budget based upon last year's cost of \$300 and have twice as many scouts participating in this program. 12 Scouts have completed the program and another 8 are expected this quarter to finish; for 20 Scouts for the year. Decision was made to pay for the following: Medallion (\$8.00), Certificate (\$1.00), Mentor Pin (\$4.00) and Mentor Certificate (\$1.00). Total Cost per participating Scout is \$9.00 and per Mentor is \$5.00. All future parents of Scouts going through this program will need to pay \$5.00 for the necessary program book. The Knot (\$1.59) and Device (\$2.99 twice) costs will be paid by the Pack. Myron Galchutt was introduced as the Religious Award Liaison for St. John's. He was trained in August of 2008 and was not previously known to the Pack. The Pack decided to ask the church to pay for the \$9.00 per Scout cost. Myron will make this request with the church. Jason Johnson will find out what if anything the Girl Scouts request for their religious awards from the church. Reimbursement payment of \$123.00 for Den 2 awards was voted and approved. Future Budget will include a better estimate of expected costs.
- IV. Website: The Geocities site has been removed and is off. The new Weebly site is working well and has received 43 hits to date. Jason Johnson will pursue a no cost option for site improvement.
- V. Pack Hike: Wade Shannon will lead this hike on November 16th at 3:00pm. This will be a Tiger/Wolf/Bear hike. Location to be determined
- VI. Den 5 wants to make a presentation at the October Pack meeting. Jason made the motion to approve this request with a second made by Chad Scott.
- VII. Popcorn: On-line ordering is not working and suggestion was made to use the printed order form.
- VIII. New Business: Trailblazer Day: Oso Lake (October 18th). About 12 scouts from the Pack are planning to attend. Pancake Griddles are being loaned out on a case-by-case basis. A release of liability has been prepared for the Pack and will be used when loaning to outside of the church. Jason Johnson outlined Samaritan

Purse program. The church has committed to 2000 boxes. The Pack sees no need to do anything as a Pack because the Scouts will already be participating through school.
