

Parent Leader Pack 51 Meeting  
February 2, 2009

Jennifer Schmid called the meeting to order at 7:33p.m. Lynn Renezeder prepared a sign in sheet.

- I. January Minutes: Minutes were reviewed and read by all. Wade Shannon motioned to approve the minutes and Ken Kressin made the second.
- II. Past Events:
  - a) Pinewood Derby – Jennifer Schmid wants the Pinewood Derby committee to review the rules, specifically grinding wheels, split races, date car built, is the check in form necessary, set height limit, alternate awards for most creative or best in show. She would like to the Pack to consider purchasing a track. David Schmid made a motion that only the wheels from the kit purchased at the scout store are allowed and no modification to the wheels other than file the burr on wheel. Second to the motion by Ken Kressin and motion was approved. Wade Shannon made the motion to expand the awards categories and will discuss with Jim Ross who is responsible for the race. The Pack will research purchasing a track for next year's race. The current software being used to manage the race is acceptable as is.
  - b) Midway Overnight – Great time and program was well done. The pack will review going again in 3 years. A day trip is an option for those who want to visit again earlier than the 3 years.
  - c) January Pack Meeting – Jennifer Schmid wants rules to be established for the uniform inspections. Wade will prepare the rules and the rules will be announced at a future Pack meeting. Advancement Ladder will be revamped to include Tiger rank. Eric Renezeder is responsible for this task. The Pack has two requests regarding the new Advancement Ladder: boys are able to move their piece and that the pieces are easy to make for new scouts.
- III. Treasurer Report: Irene reported that there is currently \$3,500 in the bank account. The Pack spent \$252 for the Pinewood Derby. The original budget was \$300.00. The Pack donated \$200.00 to the St. John's Food Pantry in honor of their sponsorship of the Pack. The money will be used to purchase food for the Food Pantry which will be given on Scout Sunday. Chad Scott informed the group that the Target Gift Cards (valued at \$ 5 per card) inventory is low. The current supply will take the Pack through the next regular pack meeting for April 2009.
- IV. Awards: Submission due to Wade Shannon for February on February 15<sup>th</sup>.
- V. February Pack Meeting: February 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 the 2009 Blue and Gold Dinner will be held in the St. John's Dining Room. Lynn Renezeder is in charge of this event.

- VI. Scout Sunday: February 8<sup>th</sup> in the Sanctuary. Rehearsal will be held at 9:00am on February 7<sup>th</sup>. All scouts receiving awards are expected to attend. Pack 51 is donating to the St. John's Food Pantry as a thank you for the sponsorship of St. John's Lutheran Church. A thank you letter will also be written on behalf of the Pack. Ken Kressin's patrol is responsible for the thank you letter. Religious awards are to be ready for presentation.
- VII. Pancake Breakfast: March 15<sup>th</sup> from 7:15am until after 11:00am. Wade Shannon is responsible for this event. Marketing will consist of selling tickets by scouts individually and by Den on the two Sundays before the event, as well as a banner hanging on Schaffer Street and have an advertisement in the school and church bulletins. Chad reported that the preschool would also help advertise to their families. Wade reported the following schedule for pancake breakfast ticket sales by Den. March 1<sup>st</sup>: Wolf Cubs from 9:00am until 9:30 and Bears from 10:30am until 11:00am. March 8<sup>th</sup> Webelos from 9:00am until 9:30 and Tiger Cubs from 10:30am until 11:00am. During these times, the boys will sell extra ticket (not the ones received individually). Wade will provide the tickets and change box for these selling events.
- VIII. Arrow of Light- March 23<sup>rd</sup> in the Sanctuary of St. John's. Chad Scott reported that all is well with the planning and executing of this event
- IX. Camp Wiley: Jennifer Schmid reported for Jodi Rahn that 26 scouts have register and 18 adults.
